CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

Theme: Real students sharing real stories of struggle and resiliency. Storytelling through video is a powerful tool to help others realize that they are not alone and that we all struggle to find ways to deal with life's challenges—addiction, identity, mental health, grief and family issues, to name a few.

Eligibility: Maine students, working individually or as a team

Submit By: March 15, 2022

Details: Using your choice of creative expression, we invite you to submit a video that shares what's going on behind the mask. How are you, or someone you know, dealing with life's challenges? Your video may feature a short movie, a play, music, poetry, photography, animation, interviews, etc., or any other form of expression, to tell your story.

Finalists will have their submissions shared virtually as part of the Voices of Hope Student Video Festival via a link on the Voices of Hope and Recovery website. Some may be included in the documentary series Voices of Hope, The Rugged Road to Recovery, to be aired on Maine Public Television in the Spring of 2022.
